Dr. Eric Hughes Scholarship

Eligibility

The applicant must be a student at (or have applied for admission to) the University of Washington.

How to Apply

Applications are available from the web site or address below.

First-year applicants

- **Three letters of recommendation** are also required.
- Letters may be from a coach, teacher, minister, or employer but not from a relative.
- Attach the letters to your application, or have each writer submit directly (recommended).

Second-year applicants (*letters of recommendation not required.*)

- Your attendance at practices, competitions, and fundraising events during your first year on the team will be reviewed by the scholarship committee. Priority and amount will favor those gymnasts with perfect and/or excellent attendance.
- Your gymnastics contribution to the team will also be measured and reviewed by the committee.

Third-year applicants (*letters of recommendation not required.*)

- Your leadership qualities with respect to the team will be considered for a third-year award. Priority and amount will favor those gymnasts showing the ability to responsibly lead the team.
- Your gymnastics contribution to the team will also be measured and reviewed by the committee.

Fourth-year applicants (*letters of recommendation not required.*)

- Your contribution to recruiting, involvement with the WMGF Board, or the gymnastics community (scoring system, judging, team representative, coaching) will be reviewed by the committee.
- Your gymnastics contribution to the team will also be measured and reviewed by the committee.

Who Will Award the Scholarship?

A panel of three WMGF Board members will review all applications and make recommendations to the Board for final decisions.

Three criteria (in no particular order) will be used to award scholarships:

1. Financial need
2. Academic standing and potential
3. Gymnastics ability

These criteria may be considered equally in selecting recipients.

What is the WMGF?

The Foundation financially supports the gymnasts training on the Washington Men's Gymnastics Team.
